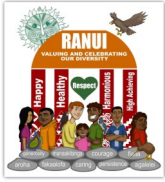

Hockey—Rosedale Park Albany

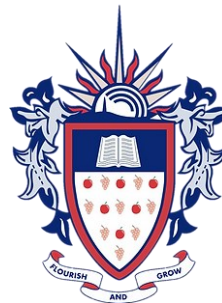

Winter Sports Exchange

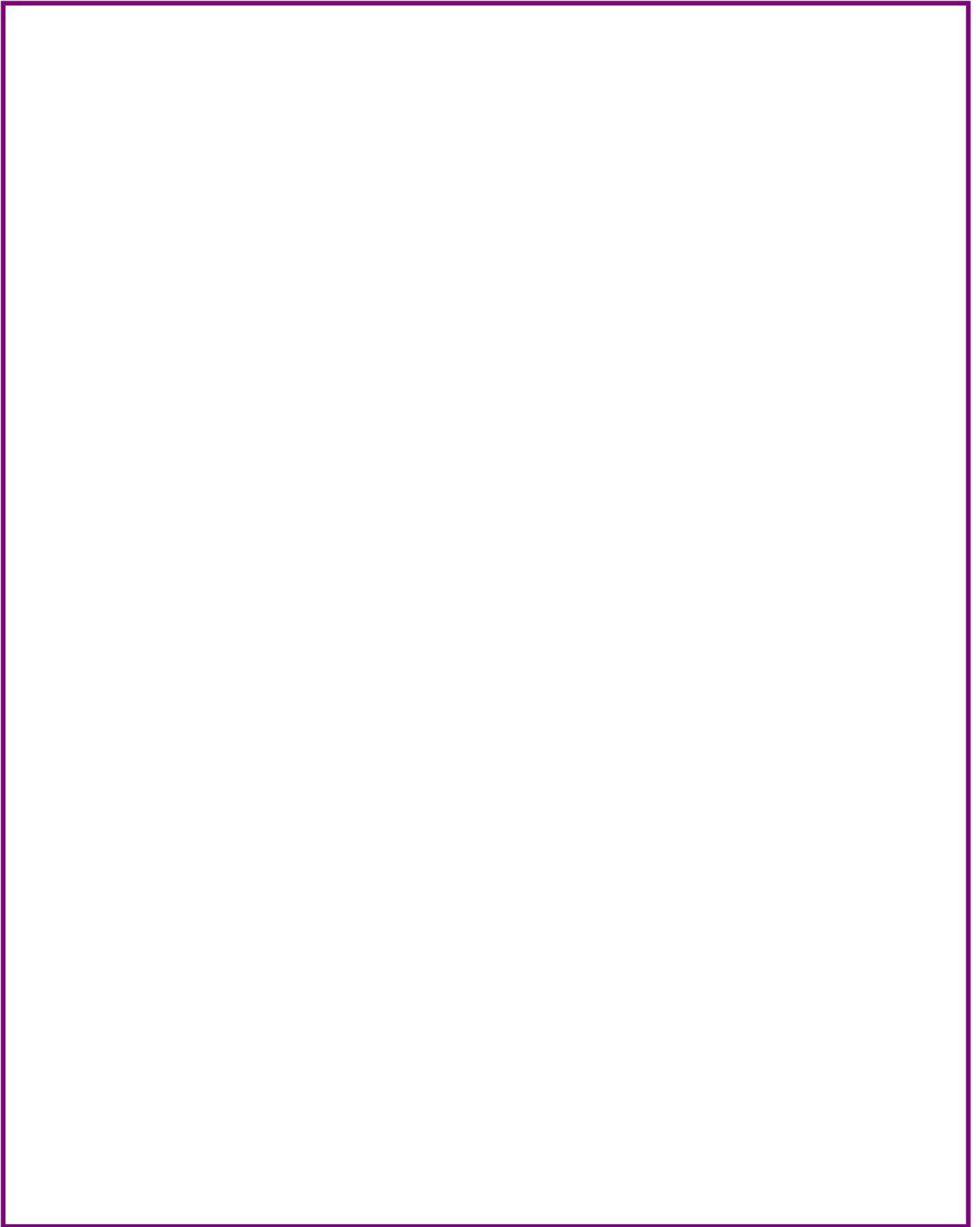

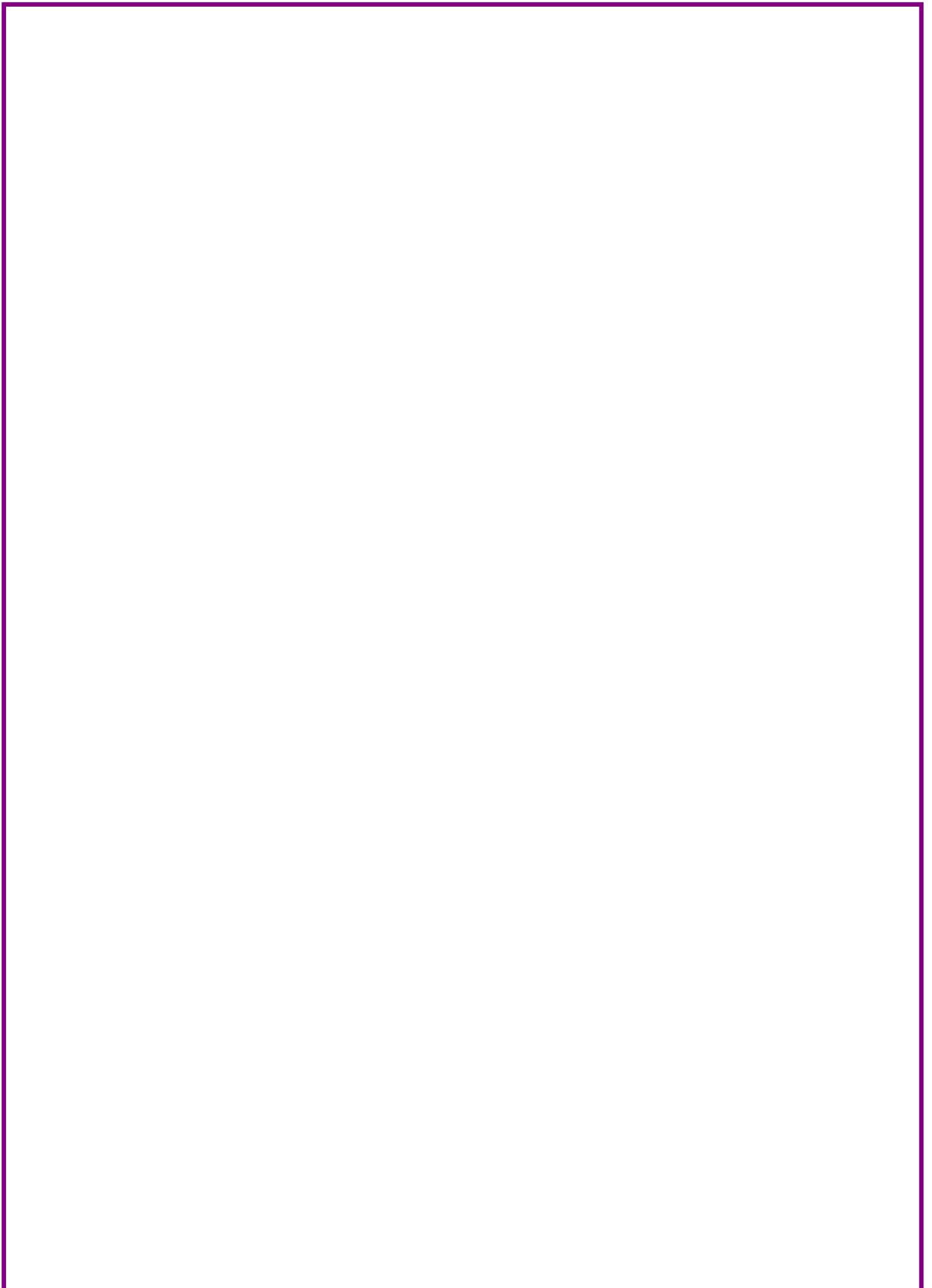

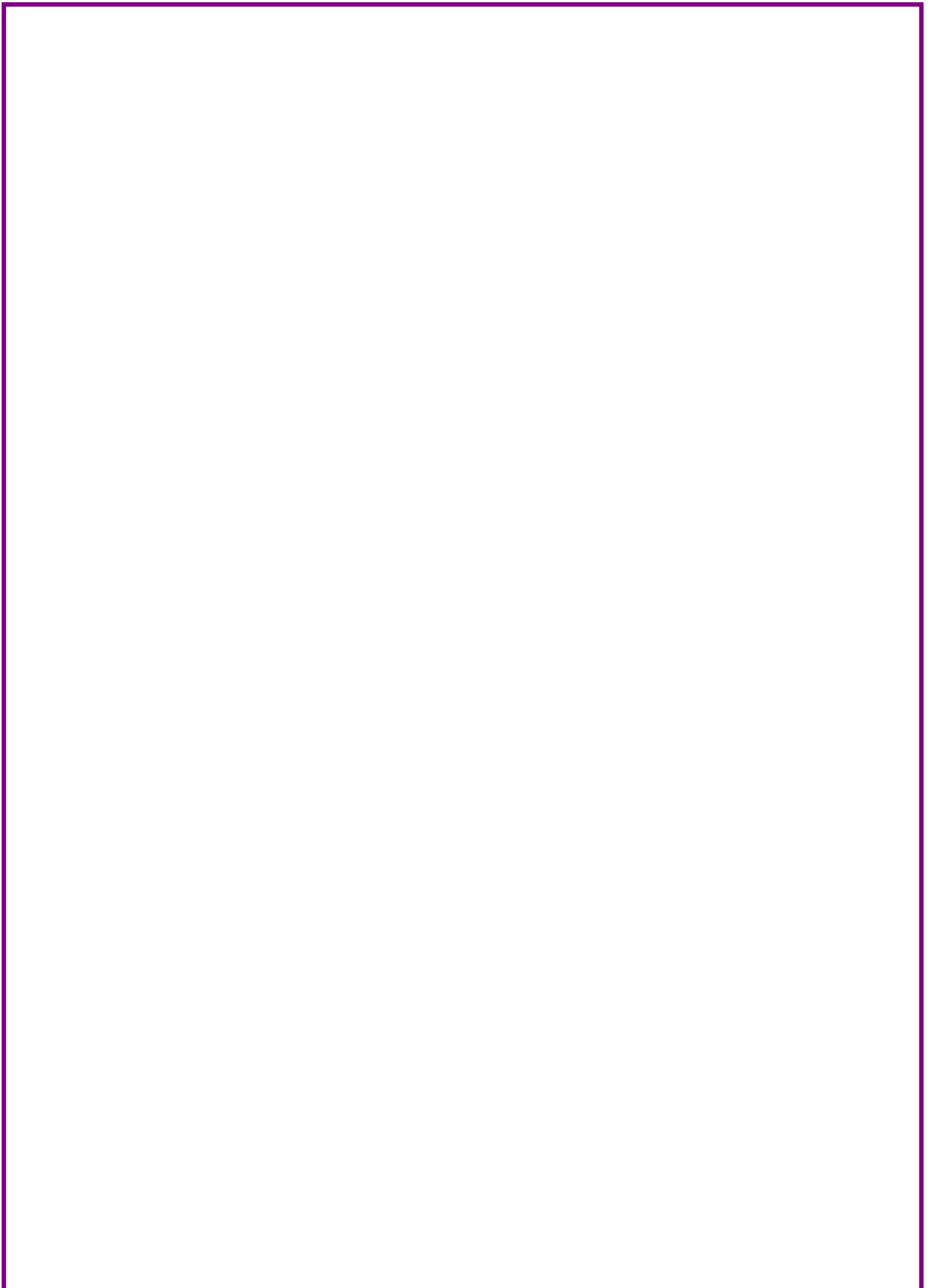
